UPDATE ON THE VARGA FAMILY: 13 APRIL 2011

We have received the following update from Clara, a member of the Pro Prietenia team and a neighbour of Saveta Varga and her family:

We want you to know that the family from Santana is doing much better thanks to your help. The family's debt has been paid and they are receiving food from us. All receipts are stored in a file at the Foundation. Every month they will continue to receive food in the amount of 100 lei (20 pounds).

Meanwhile they are sorting out the paperwork for their house. I have been at the Town hall and talked with the person in charge; the grandmother has already submitted a request for the house's contract to be switched from the deceased daughter's name to the children's names. This will allow them also to make the necessary paperwork for the grandfather's pension.

Meanwhile the grandmother is trying to find a place to work as she still has a few years until she can retire. Incredible as it seems, she did find a job and she is now in the trial work period at a small sewing factory in Santana. If she gets hired this will improve their situation so much.

The family are already so much better: you can see their optimism and renewed struggle for a normal life. The help they got came at the right time and has given them hope for life as a family. They still have many needs and problems but we hope they will be able to face up to them well.
