I thank all those people who have supported our efforts in the past by their prayers, their involvement in our activities and their financial contributions. You have helped bring us to this point; it is upon the foundation you have helped lay that our Charity is built, and hopefully, it is upon your continued support that we will become whatever the future needs us to be to serve the changing needs of the people.

At the end of this, our first year, I would like to thank our Trustees for freely giving of their time and expertise. We are aware of the need to recruit new blood onto the Board of Trustees, and this we aim to do in

By the way, thanks for the memories – it was good spending the time with you.

I am thankful to the Romanian Ambassador to UK, Dr Ion Jinga, and to the consular staff for the interest they have taken in our Charity this year. I am thankful to the public officials and dignitaries in Arad for always being ready to meet with us when we visit their wonderful city and county of Arad.

Last, and by no means least, I am thankful to our supporters, without whom we should not exist and, worse still, without whom hundreds of people would be denied the benefits of a humane response to their needs. Our supporters have never failed us and it is a privilege for our Charity to be entrusted with the mechanism which helps convert financial generosity into practical benefits. Thank you for enabling us to work on your behalf.
